Physalis card

(by Christine Quincy)



Material

Katzelkraft stamps: Physalis
Versamagic inks: Wheat & Pumpkin Spice
Cuttlebug embossing folder: Ornamental Iron
Nestabilities: label one
Embossing powder: Disco Black
Versafine ink: black
White and black card
3D foam squares



30 à 40 min.

1/ Cut a piece of 11x14 cm card and ink it with the two Versamagic inks using a Cut'n dry sponge or direct from the inkpads. Stamp the two Katzelkraft flowers with Pumpkin Spice Versamagic. Mat it with a black card or paper.

2/ Ink up a 7x7 cm white card with the Versamagic inks. Emboss it with the Cuttlebug Ornamental Iron embossing folder and cut it with the Nestabilities Label One die. Mat with black card or paper.

Glue it on the top left of the first card.

3/ Punch out a border in a black card and glue as shown.

4/ Ink up a white piece of card (4,5x10,5 cm) with the same Versamagic inks and dry with a heat gun. Stamp the long flower with black Versafine and emboss it with the Disco Black embossing powder. Stamp the swirls with black Versafine (don't emboss them) and mat with black paper or card and attach it to the card.

5/ Ink up a card with Pumpkin Spice Versamagic ink and dry. Stamp the flower three times and emboss them with Disco Black embossing powder. Cut them out and attach them to the card with 3d foam squares.

6/ Ink up a small rectangle with Pumpkin Spice Versamagic ink and dry. Stamp a greeting, trim and mat with a black paper and add to the card.
